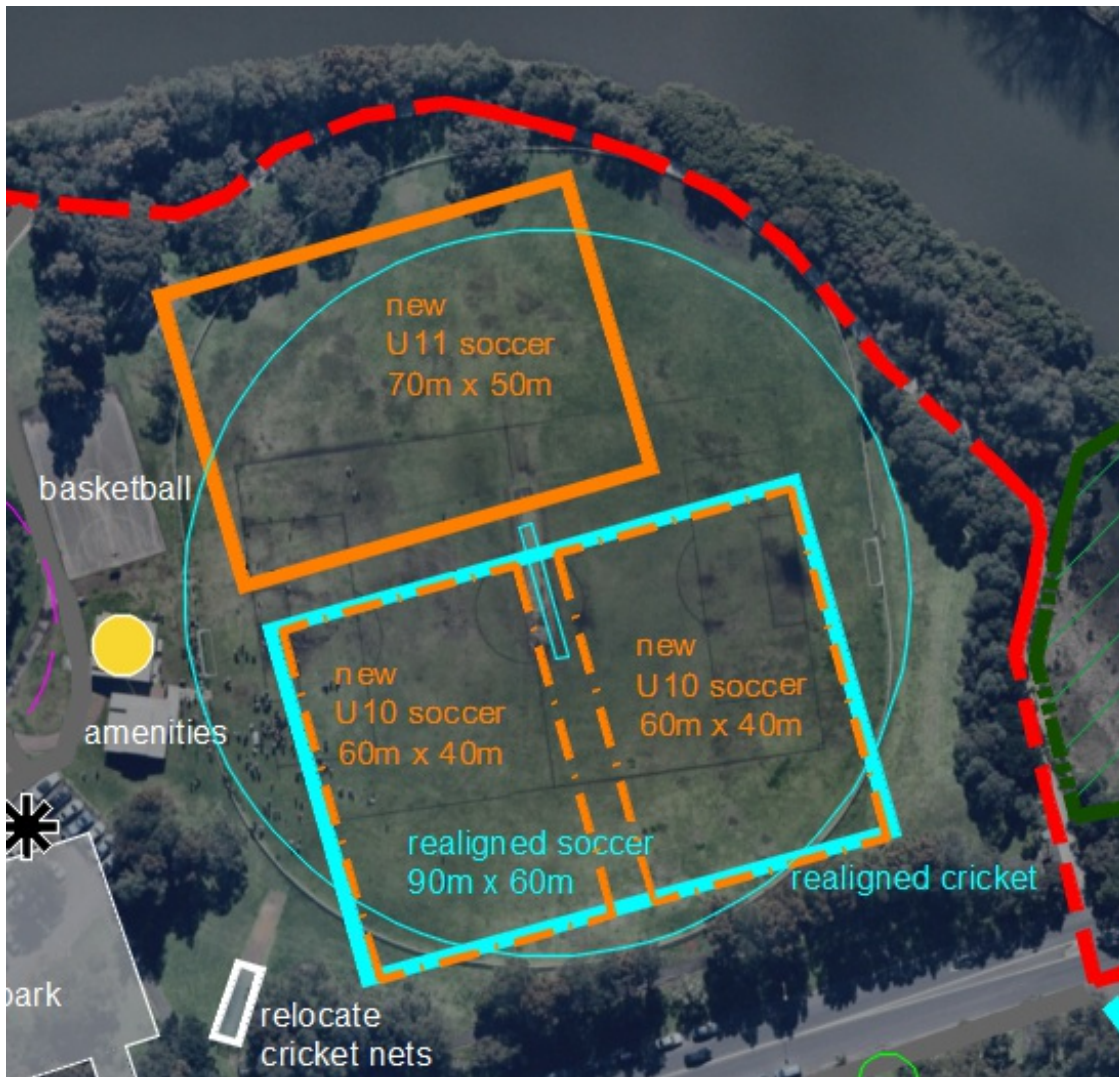
Gough Whitlam Park Cricket and Soccer Field

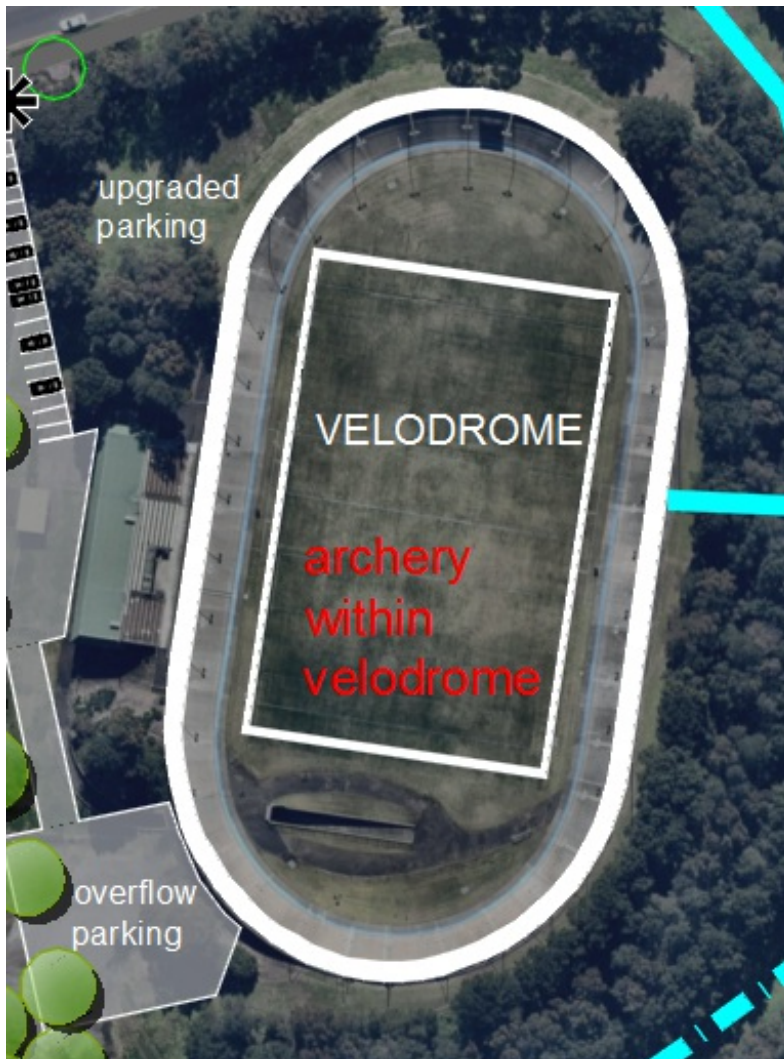

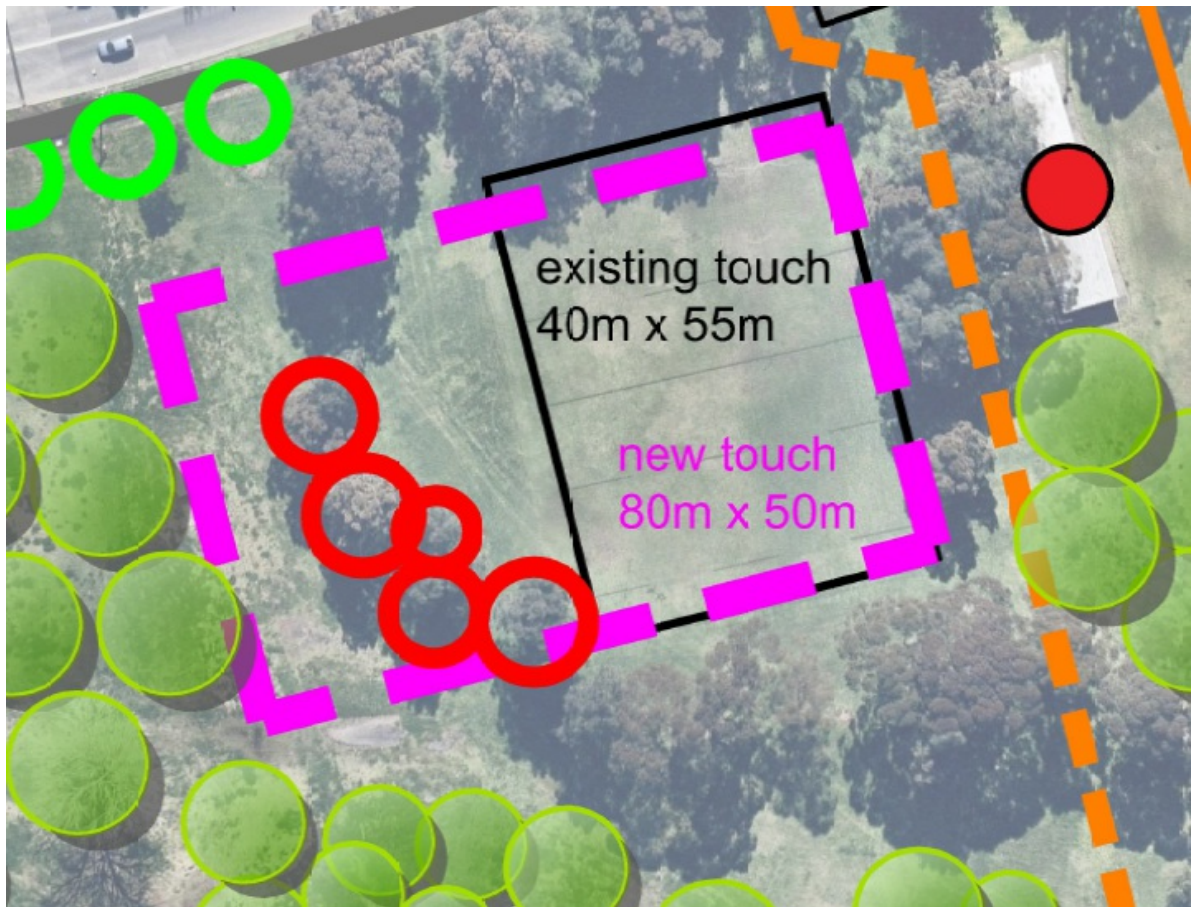
