In 2018, extensive community consultation was conducted, to find out how local parks and playgrounds were used in Canterbury-Bankstown.

From that feedback, we developed a new **10-year Playground Strategy**. The Strategy help guide the future maintenance and upgrading of existing facilities, and the installation of play equipment in any new parks developed to meet the needs of our growing population.

We asked residents to provide comment on the draft document and then, once further adjustments were made, the **Playground Strategy** was adopted.

What's next?

- The playground at **Rosedale Reserve** is scheduled to be upgraded.
- The playground at **Broad Street Reserve** will be maintained as usual.
- The old playground at **Bowden Park** will be removed and the park returned to open space in 2020/21.
