#EatGlobalVisitLocal Photo Competition Terms and Conditions

Instructions, prizes and information on how to enter form part of these Terms and Conditions. By entering, entrants accept these Terms and Conditions.

How to enter

In order for an entry to be valid, an entrant must, during the competition period:

 Take at least one photo in an eligible eatery you dine in (the eatery must be listed in the Business Directory <u>cb.city/eatglobal</u>), and upload the photo to Facebook or Instagram with the hashtag #EatGlobalVisitLocal.

Eligibility
