## **Canterbury Town Centre Stage Two**

**Proposed Site Compound** 

As part of the 2020/21 capital works program the \$8.9 million Canterbury Town Centre Upgrade - Stage 2 has commenced. The key components of this upgrade are:

- The realignment of Canterbury Road, Close Street and Charles Street intersection and installation of new traffic signals; and
- The upgrade of the Cooks River Shared Pathway (under Canterbury Road) by lowering and widening the pathway and installing lights.

This upgrade will deliver improved safety levels for all users of the Canterbury Road, Close Street and Charles Street intersection and the Cooks River Shared Pathway underpass.

Council is proposing to establish a temporary work site compound in Close Street Reserve (Lesley Muir Reserve) which will primarily be used for the storage of steel, generators, tools, timber, plastic frames and sand.

Notice is hereby given of the formal public exhibition of a proposed license to Abergeldie ABN 47 004 533 519 to use part of Close St Reserve (Lesley Muir Reserve), 15A Close Street, Canterbury (Part Lot 2 DP 818682).

Lesley Muir Reserve is a community-classified reserve owned and managed by the City of Canterbury Bankstown. It contains parkland, pathways and an off-leash dog area.

Under the proposed license the licensee is to use Close St Reserve (Lesley Muir Reserve) as a site compound. The term of the proposed license is six months.
