
Design Statement

The Wiley Park Master plan was developed in response to community engagement undertaken in 2018. The following guiding principles were established for Wiley Park:

Council is prioritising pond rehabilitation works to improve safety, water quality and visitor experience and has engaged Turf Design Studio to develop and implement strategies in the Master plan prepared by Gallagher Studio on behalf of Canterbury Bankstown City Council.



Upper pond

- 1. Existing stairs to be upgraded
- 2. Proposed concrete path pond surrounds
- 3. Proposed timber deck lookout
- 4. Proposed sandstone bleacher steps
- 5. Proposed Timber stepping elements
- 6. Proposed 1:4 battered edge into wetland area (600m2)
- 7. Proposed pond edge
- 8. Existing upper pond to be upgraded
- 9. Proposed inset reed planting
- 10. Existing bridge to be upgraded – concrete bridge with steel balustrade
- 11. Proposed concrete path
- 12. Existing park perimeter path to be retained
- 13. Proposed planting/embellished planting
- 14. Proposed lawn/embellished lawn
- 15. Proposed concrete path linking pond system

Lower pond

1. Proposed viewing platform with balustrade lean rail
2. Proposed raised lawn picnic area
3. Existing dimensioned stonewall to be retained
4. Existing bridge to be upgraded
5. Stacked stone wall
6. Proposed concrete ramp
7. Retain existing concrete path
8. Proposed concrete stairs
9. Proposed equal access concrete walkway
10. Proposed pond edge
11. Proposed 1:4 battered edge into wetland area (600m²)
12. Proposed deco-gravel path
13. Existing lower pond to be upgraded
14. Proposed planting/embellished planting
15. Existing concrete path linking pond system
16. Stage 1 boundary line
